## 1. Investments & Innovations in hotels/restaurants

## **NEW HOTELS & RESTAURANTS**

## Uncomplicated: Motel by Maier

The Vorarlberg real estate group Maier operates several business hotels in Vorarlberg. The latest addition is the "Motel by Maier" in Feldkirch, which opened in September 2023. It comprises 12 double rooms in two categories. There is a choice of 18 m² or 30 m² rooms with a balcony and small kitchen. Check-in machines allow access around the clock. Free parking is available for guests. Feldkirch train station is around 15 minutes' walk away.

#### Individual: Blaue Rose Feldkirch

The self-check-in boutique hotel Blaue Rose opened in Feldkirch in December 2023. The small hotel is located in a carefully renovated 500-year-old house in the city center. All the work was carried out by local craftsmen. The "Blaue Rose" has 18 individually furnished rooms, ranging from 10  $\,\mathrm{m}^2$  economy single rooms to 21  $\,\mathrm{m}^2$  family rooms. One of the double rooms is wheelchair accessible.

## With Bregenzerwald-view: Hotel Marvia

The Hotel Marvia on the Bödele above Dornbirn celebrated its opening in mid-December 2023. It is located in the former Berghof Fetz, which closed down in summer 2023. Host family Metzler, who also run the Hotel Gretina in Bezau, have modernized the restaurant and kitchen. The 10 rooms will be redesigned from spring 2024. All have a balcony with a beautiful view of the Bregenzerwald. The hotel also includes the legendary party location "Felsenkeller", which can be used for events of all kinds. www.berghoffetz.at

## Architectural jewel: Hotel Kleiner Löwe

At the beginning of April 2024, the new city hotel Kleiner Löwe will open on the centrally located Kornmarktplatz in Bregenz. The plans for the narrow, five-storey building, which houses just eight rooms, were drawn up by the multi-award-winning Basel architects Herzog & de Meuron. The eyecatching feature of the building is a barrel roof made from over 30 wooden arches. The breakfast bar for hotel guests and the lounge, which is also open to external visitors, are located on the first floor with a view of the inner garden. The hotel takes its name from the "Gasthaus zum Löwen" brewery, which was located here in the 19th century.

## New apartments: Dornbirn camping

## HIKING, BIKING & Co.

#### Via ferrata Großes Walsertal

In early summer 2024, a new, moderately difficult via ferrata of category C will open on the Wandfluh in Sonntag-Stein in the Großes Walsertal Biosphere Park. Over a length of 200 meters, climbers will overcome around 150 meters in altitude in around an hour. Along the way, there are wonderful views of the alpine valley and its mountains. The start is around 30 minutes' walk from the Sonntag-Stein cable car mountain station.

## Running around Bludenz

## Propstei St. Gerold cultural meeting point

The Propstei St. Gerold in the Großes Walsertal biosphere reserve has always been a center for culture and encounters. The complex has recently been given a new lease of life. In several stages, with great care and in cooperation with the Vorarlberg architect Hermann Kaufmann, the Propstei has renovated its listed buildings. The project was completed with the reopening of the main building in mid-April 2024, the patron saint's day of St. Gerold. The challenge was to combine historical features with modern production. The craftsmen produced replicas of historical heating cladding using laser printers, for example. Modern technology and fire protection equipment are concealed in wooden walls and floors. On the renovated roof, a wood and steel construction surrounds wooden beams from the 17th century. The reopened building houses guest rooms, seminar rooms, offices and church rooms. It is also the venue for concerts and exhibitions. The first exhibition is entitled "The Holy Anhauche" and can be seen until November 10, 2024.

## Alpin8 in Brand for the first time

Alpin8 is a mountain running event in which participants run uphill under their own steam for 8,848 meters - the equivalent of the height of Mount Everest. The organizers call this challenging task "Everesting". Alpin8 will take place for the first time in Brand in Brandnertal from June 21 to 23, 2024. A maximum of 250 participants will run up the mountain seventeen times in a time window of 36 hours. The gondola will be in operation for 36 hours on the way down.

The program includes concerts by renowned alphorn groups from German-speaking countries as well as the final choir with all the alphorn players.

## Major anniversaries in Vorarlberg

## 200 years of Lake Constance shipping

Lake Constance shipping is celebrating its 200th anniversary with a fleet rally on April 27, 2024. The first passenger steamboat on Lake Constance went into operation on November 10, 1824. The "Wilhelm" offered space for 124 passengers. It traveled between the German city of Friedrichshafen and Romanshorn as well as Rorschach in Switzerland. Other steamships were soon on their way. Bregenz was initially served by German ships. But in the k. u. k. Monarchy, however, there was a desire to establish its own shipping company. From 1884, the steamships "Austria" and "Habsburg" were in operation. The "Caroline", "Bregenz" and the semi-saloon steamers "Kaiser Franz Josef I." and "Kaiserin Elisabeth" joined the fleet after a few years.

To this day, the cruise and excursion ships sail on Lake Constance under the Austrian, German and Swiss flags. Vorarlberg Lines", with its home port of Bregenz, operates six ships of different sizes. ## 10 years of BUS:STOP Krumbach

The plans for the works were drawn up by Sou Fujimoto from Japan, Alexander Brodsky from Russia, Smiljan Radic from Chile, Architecten de Vylder Vinck Taillieu from Belgium, Ensamble Studio from Spain, Rintala Eggertsson Architects from Norway and Wang Shu and Ly Wenyu from China.

Event highlights in the anniversary year include the festive concert on the Day of Brass Music in Feldkirch Cathedral (May 5, 2024), the performance of the magical brass music show "Zirkus Luft-i-kuss" at the Festspielhaus in Bregenz (June 2, 2024) and the "World Record of Brass Music" on August 25, 2024. Around 10,000 brass musicians will perform together on the Vorarlberg and Swiss sides of the Rhine. From May 17 until spring 2025, the vorarlberg museum in Bregenz will be showing the special exhibition "tuten & blasen". Numerous concerts and brass band festivals in the towns and villages complete the festival program.
